Online application for Ambassador's Scholarship 2026-27 Frequently Asked Questions

S. No	Questions	Answer
1.	I can't access the online application from the EoI website link. I am trying to apply from my mobile device/tablet.	You are requested to apply using a laptop or a desktop PC. Please do not use mobile device for applying.
2.	I am a fresh undergraduate student passed out from a college of Bhutan. I have not yet taken admission in an Indian University/ Institute/ College. Am I eligible to apply for the scholarship.	As of date of application, if you are not enrolled in a regular UG/PG course in an Indian Institution, you are <u>NOT</u> eligible to apply.
3.	I have completed my Bachelor's/ Master's degree from an Indian university in May/ June 2026? At present, I am studying (or working) in Bhutan now, can I apply.	As you have already passed out from the Indian institution and you have completed your studies in India, you are <u>NOT</u> eligible to apply.
4.	I am in the first semester/ first term/ first year of UG/PG studies in my college India. Which marksheet should I upload?	As stated in the application form, if you are in your 1 st semester/ term/ year of Bachelor's degree, you may upload your Class XII marksheet. If you are in 1 st Semester/Year of Master's degree, then please upload your final Bachelor's degree marksheet.
5.	I am a student in an Indian institute with DAHE/ RCSC scholarship/ ICCR/ GOI scholarship. Am I eligible to apply?	All Bhutanese students who are in receipt of any DAHE/ RCSC RGoB/ ICCR/ GOI Scholarship are <u>NOT</u> eligible to apply. All applicants are required to confirm that they are <u>not in receipt of any such scholarship.</u>

6.	Reference Bank details section of the application. I don't have a bank account in any Bhutanese/ Indian bank. Can I give the account number of my parents or some other relatives.	The last date of application for the scholarship is 14 October 2026. Thus, there is sufficient time for you to open a bank in any of the Bhutanese/ Indian Bank. You <u>CANNOT</u> submit bank account details of your parents or anyone else in the online application form.
7.	I am studying in a University in Bangladesh/ Thailand/ Australia/ UK/ USA. Can I apply.	<u>The first requirement of</u> eligibility for the Ambassador' Scholarship is that you must be a <u>Bhutanese national who is enrolled and studying in an Indian University/ Institution.</u> Thus, you are <u>NOT</u> eligible to apply.
8.	I can't submit the online application. There seems to be an error message when I try to submit the applications.	Please note that all the fields marked with <u>a red asterisk (*)</u> <u>are mandatory fields</u> required to be filled in. Thus, your application will not be complete till you fill all the mandatory fields of the application and upload all the necessary documents required to support your scholarship application.
9.	I am studying in Indian university in distance learning mode. Am I eligible to apply.	No, Students studying in distance learning mode are not eligible for the scholarship.
