Nehru Wangchuck Scholarship Programme for the Academic Year 2025-26

The Embassy of India and Royal Government of Bhutan invite applications from Bhutanese civil servants and private individuals for the award of Nehru Wangchuck Scholarship for the Academic Year 2025-26. The Scholarship is aimed at supporting studies at Post Graduate Programmes in India's premier educational institutions. Nine Nehru-Wangchuck Scholarships would be available, covering all expenditure, in India.

- 2. Following benefits are extended to recipients of the Nehru Wangchuck Scholarship:
 - Full Tuition fees and other admission-related charges;
 - Rs.50,000/- monthly stipend;
 - Rs. 12,500/- annual book allowance;
 - Rs. 10,000/- as one-time establishment allowance;
 - Thesis/Research Grant of Rs. 63,000/- (for research-based courses)
 - Airfare; and
 - Health insurance coverage.
- 3. The priority areas of studies identified by the Royal Government of Bhutan under the Nehru Wangchuck Scholarship for 2025-26 are: Economics; Mathematics; Physics; Law; Geodesy; Statistics/Applied Statistics; Medical (Technical); Management; Tourism/Hospitality Management; and Media Studies.
