- 3. The Preliminary Round of the Quiz will be held on a digital platform, with 15 multiple-choice questions to be answered by the participating school teams. The Preliminary Round of the Quiz may be seen live on the Facebook Page of the Embassy of India @IndiainBhutan.
- 4. The top four highest scoring school teams in the Preliminary Round will reach the Final Round of the Quiz on Buddhism, which will be broadcast live on BBS TV2 on 1 December 2021.
- 5. The first prize for the top scoring team in the Final Round of the Quiz will be a 5-day all expenses paid tour to two Buddhist sites in India, sponsored by the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India. The other three finalist teams will also receive attractive cash prizes and merit certificates.
