New hostel facilities and a Food Science and Technology Laboratory inaugurated at the College of Natural Resources, Punakha

New hostel facilities and a Food Science and Technology Laboratory were inaugurated at College of Natural Resources, Punakha on 11 April, 2023. The facilities have been constructed as Bhutan-India Development Partnership projects under the 12th Five Year Plan of Bhutan. Ambassador of India to Bhutan, Shri Sudhakar Dalela and the President, College of Natural Resources, Dasho Sonam Wangchuk attended the inauguration ceremony.
