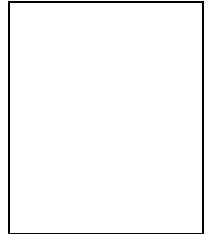

The Nehru-Wangchuck Cultural Centre has good stock of books on countries in the region on various subjects such as religion, culture, biographies, fiction, literature, history, economy, Foreign affairs, business related books, health, agriculture, states of India and travel books. The library also has a section of children's books.

2. Membership of the NWCC library is open to all interested nationals of Bhutan and Indians. Third country nationals residing in Thimphu, may also be a member of the library at the discretion of the Director, NWCC. The application form should be enclosed with two (2) passport size photographs. Each member shall be issued with a membership card, which will enable him/her to use the library facilities and to borrow books from it.

### **Rules of the Library**

i. Only members of the NWCC library shall be permitted to borrow books from the Library.

ii. Not more than two books will be issued to a member at a time for a period of two weeks.

iii. In case a borrower fails to return the book(s) borrowed from the Library, he/she will be liable to pay a fine of Nu.5/- per day per book.

iv. Loss of a book or any damage to a book should be reported to the Library immediately.

v. Any such loss or damage may entail recovery of full cost of the book/replacement from the borrower.

vi. No reference books, newspaper and periodicals will be taken out of the Library.

vii. The Library will be open on working days of the NWCC i.e Monday to Friday from 09:00 am -1:00pm in the morning and 2:00 pm - 5.30 pm in the evening.
